HOW TO HANDLE CUSTOMERS NAMES THAT ARE NOT JUST FIRST/LAST NAMES

TRUST:

Seller or Buyer:Jim Bailey Living Trust dated July 1, 2015.Signature (if Seller):Jim Bailey, Individually and as TrusteeSignature (if Buyer):Jim Bailey, as Trustee

Note – need to confirm who the acting Trustee is with the client.

<u>LLC:</u>

Seller or Buyer:	Florida Beach LLC, a Florida limited liability company (or different state)
Signature:	Jim Bailey, as Authorized Member (if Member Managed).
Signature:	Jim Bailey, as Manager (if <u>Manager</u> Managed).

Note – need to confirm the Managing Member name with the client.

CORPORATION:

Seller or Buyer:Florida Beach LLC, a Florida Corporation (or different state)Signature:Jim Bailey, as President (or Vice President, or CEO)

Note – need to confirm the correct Name AND Title with the client.

POWER OF ATTORNEY:

Seller or Buyer: Insert the actual buyer or seller name that is on the DEED. For example: "John Hancock" is on the Deed

Signature: John Hancock by Jim Bailey as his attorney in fact

Note – need to confirm the POA is a "Specific POA" for Real Estate. Many General POAs do not cover real estate sales in Florida. Confirm with a Real Estate Attorney.
